

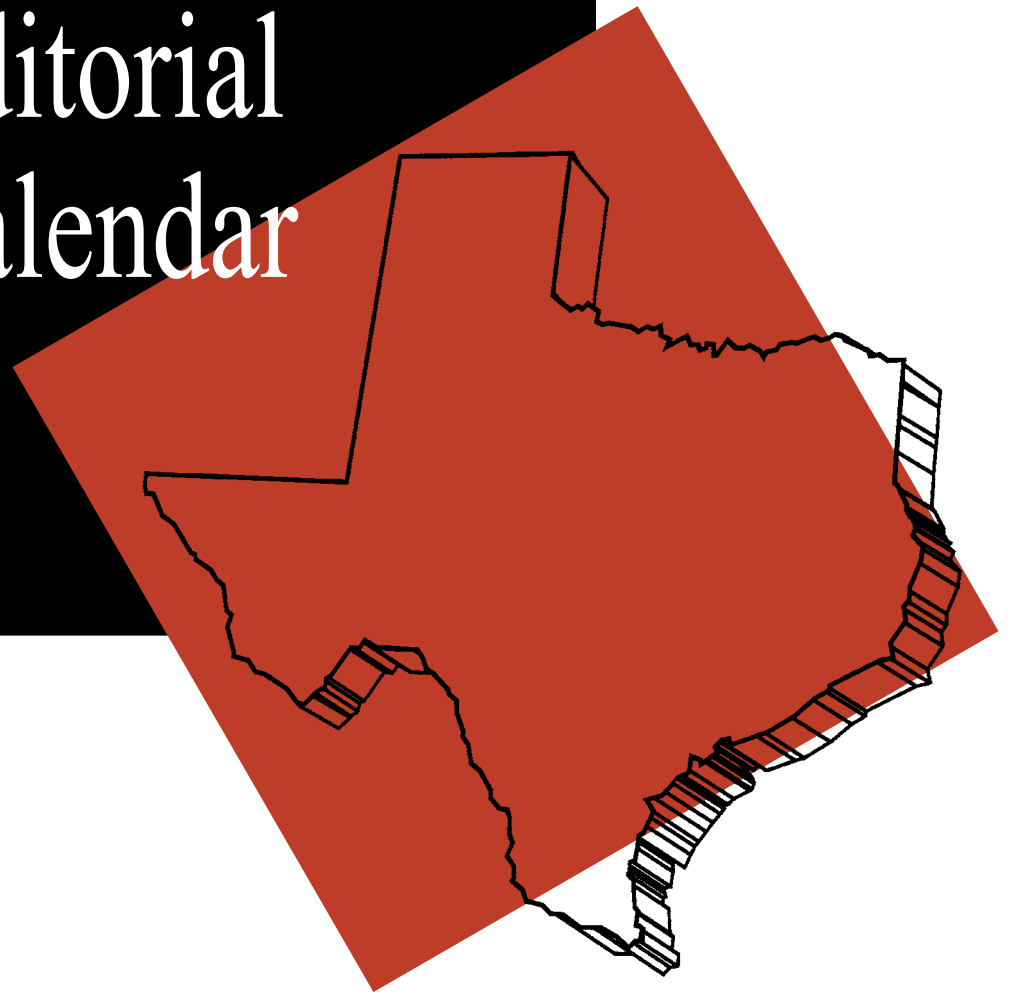

Mechanical Requirements

PRINTING SPECIFICATIONS:

Newspaper tabloid. Printed non-heatset, web offset, on premium grade newsprint. Page consists of five columns, each 1 3/4" wide, 68 3/4 column inches per page. Trim size: 10 1/2" x 14 1/2".

BLEED: Not Available.

INSERTS:

Single Leaf: Normal, 8 1/2" x 11"; Maximum, 10" x 13".
Double Leaf: Normal, 17" x 11"; Maximum, 20" x 13".
Inserts must have a minimum 5" lip and minimum 1/4" trim on top or bottom. Insert paper should not be heavier than 100-pound stock or lighter than 70-pound stock. Contact advertising sales representative for quantity and shipping instructions, or for information on special inserts.

ELECTRONIC DATA:

PC compatible disks. **High Resolution PDFs are preferred.** (Acrobat 4.0 or higher compatibility. Color and grayscale images set to down sample to 300 pixels/inch for images above 450. Compression should be ZIP. Monochrome images should be down sampled to 1,200 pixels/inch for images above 1,800 pixels/inch. Embed all fonts. Color should be set to U.S. Web Uncoated)

High Resolution JPEGs and High Resolution TIFs are also acceptable, with a minimum of 300 dpi. Our software actively supports: Adobe InDesign CS3, PageMaker 7.0, Adobe Photoshop CS3, Adobe Illustrator CS3 and Microsoft Word. Include all fonts and attached graphics and support files used. Please send hardcopy with disk. *A production charge will be added to produce film for advertisements received on disk or via e-mail.*

PUBLISHER SERVICES AT COST:

Design, layout and/or production of all ads. Composition changes. Shipment of materials by special delivery. *Submit proofs for approval. Minimum fee for any of the above services is 15% of the gross ad rate.*
